



Mains Water Update

Work on the water mains replacement has now started on Brookburn Road and West Meade (27th April).

A quick summary:

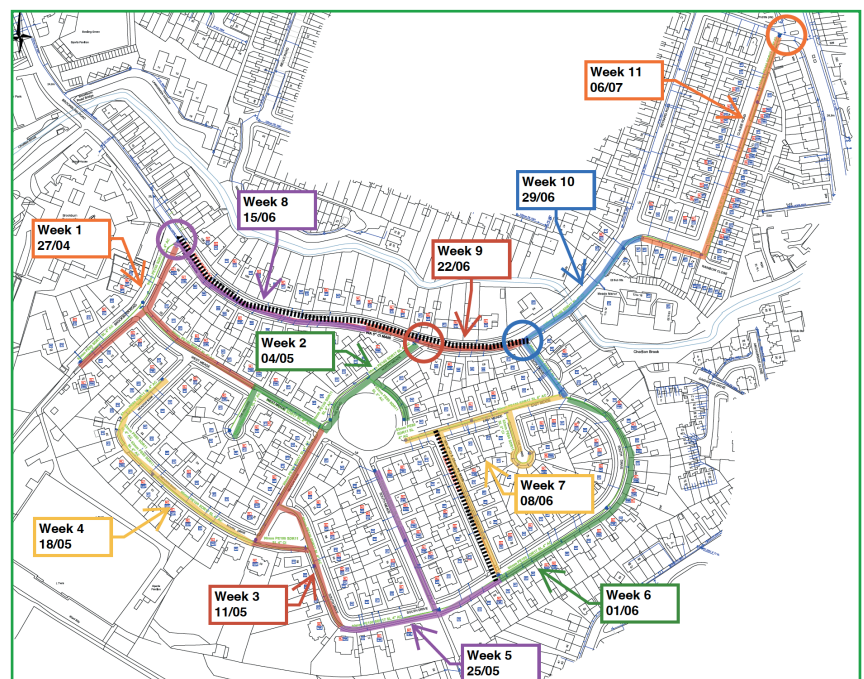
- Replacement main along Claude Road through the estate (open cut).
- Possible replacement main in Southgate (open cut).
- All other areas are currently planned for insertion with possible main replacement where there are difficulties, for example excessive tree roots or blockages.
- Pipe insertion will require pits to be excavated at approx 100m intervals, these will become new chambers.
- New connections to be provided at existing connection locations.
- Connections will only be replaced up to the property boundary where necessary. There will be no work carried out on private property as this part of the connection is the owner's responsibility.
- The works on Claude Road will be undertaken under one way traffic signals.
- Affected residents will be informed by United Utilities 48 hours in advance by letter.
- Trees will be protected and all reinstatements to be in accordance with current guidance and to original condition.

From the phasing plan supplied by United Utilities, the current schedule is:

Week 1: 27/4 Brookburn Road & West Meade (pt 1)
Week 2: 04/5 The Meade, North Meade, West Meade (pt 2), The Willows
Week 3: 11/5 Meadow Bank to the Rotunda & section of South Drive
Week 4: 18/5 Meadow Bank
Week 5: 25/5 South Meade & middle South Drive
Week 6: 01/6 remaining South Drive to East Meade

Week 7: 08/6 East Meade, The Thorns & Southgate
Week 8: 15/6 First section Claude Road
Week 9: 22/6 Second section Claude Road
Week 10: 29/6 Claude Road & South Drive from Claude Road to East Meade
Week 11: 06/7 remainder of Claude Road (Outside Chorltonville)

This may be subject to change so watch for notifications coming through the door concerning your area from United Utilities.
